- Unvaccinated associates should continue to wear face coverings & practice physical distancing.
- Masks are optional for associates working outside.
- Associates should continue daily self-screening at home.
- Associates are reminded to stay at home or seek medical treatment if exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or are unwell for other reasons.

There is currently no face covering mandate at a federal, state, or local level. As an accommodation for your group, if you would prefer for some or all of our Ambassadors to wear a face covering, we will gladly do so.

Additional steps we are taking to ensure your safety:

- Ambassadors have been fully trained in our public health protocols.
- Marriott Mobile Key is a contactless option for your guests via our Bonvoy App.
- Hand-Sanitizing stations are located throughout our resort.
- Enhanced cleaning protocols are in place for public space and high-traffic areas of the resort.
- Daily use of electrostatic sprayers with the highest classification of disinfectants recommended by the CDC.
- Encouraging 6' physical distancing.
- Daily housekeeping services are only available upon the request of our guests.
- Masks are available to guests upon request.
